International Conference of Nutritional Oncology: International workshop in cachexia and inflammation ; Nutritional intervention in advanced head and neck cancer treated by chemo and radiotherapy ; Cancer and nutrition: relevant epidemiological scientific evidence; Dietetic intervention with calcium and Vitamin D in cancer and omega-3 fatty acids and cancer prevention; The incorporation of the “ omics” concept in nutrition.

III Congresso Brasileiro de Nutrição e Câncer: Aging and diet in cancer prevention; New approaches to metabolic alterations in cancer; Nutritional management of pediatric cancer; Advances in nutrition and breast cancer, and cooking against cancer.

Ganepão 2008: Child behaviour disturbances and diets: fact or fiction? Erectile male dysfunction and nutrition; Skin aging and nutrition; Morbid obesity surgery for teen agers: multiprofessional approach; Specialized nutrition in abdominal catastrophies.
