 **John A. Milner**, Ph.D. - is chief of the Nutritional Science Research Group, Division of Cancer Prevention, National Cancer Institute. He earned a Ph.D. in nutrition from Cornell

University. He spent almost 25 years in academia at the University of Illinois and Penn State University prior to his current highly prestigious position. He is a member of several professional organizations, including the American Society for Nutrition, American Association of Cancer Research, the American Chemical Society's Food and Chemistry Division and the Institute of Food Technology. He is a fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science, Sigma Xi and an Honorary Member of the American Dietetic Association. Dr. Milner has published more than 350 abstracts, book chapters, and journal articles. In his current position he promotes research that deals with the physiological importance of dietary bioactive compounds as modifiers of cancer risk and tumor behavior. Is a member the Organizing Committee of the International Conference of Nutritional Oncology (ICNO).




**🇨🇦 Daren Keith Heyland MD, FRCPC, MSc.** - Dr Heyland is currently the Full Professor of Medicine, Queen's University. He is specialized in surgery and critical care, following a Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine at University of Alberta and a Master's Degree in Health Sciences at McMaster University. He was awarded with many prizes in research in the past two decades and is Scientific Reviewer for several major impact Journals (Journal of the American Medical Association, Chest, American Journal of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine, Intensive Care Medicine, Critical Care, Journal of Palliative Care). Currently he supervises the research work of eight student/ postdoctoral fellows, and participates as lecturer in many international and national important medical meetings. He has more than 120 papers published in international journals.
